



Foliage and Summer/Fall Flower

Characteristics:

Herbaceous, Perennial, Nonpersistent

Appearance:

Height - 2 to 4 feet

Spread - 1 to 2 feet

Flower Color - Red

Foliage Color - Green

Flowering Period - June through September

Light - Full sun to part shade

Water - Average to wet

Wildlife Benefits: Food (nectar) for hummingbird, oriole, and butterflies.

Distribution: New Brunswick to Michigan and Minnesota, south to Florida and Texas

Likes moist locations along stream banks, clump forming, good for woodland and shade gardens.
